Engineer Someday: A Bilingual STEM Adventure

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Themes: Engineering, Creativity, Problem-Solving, Imagination, Careers

Book Brief: Meet ten different types of engineers and imagine all the amazing things you could design and build someday.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Look at the cover together. Ask, “What do you think an engineer does? What kinds of things might engineers create or build?”

While Reading: Make Connections

- What different types of engineers do you notice?
- What do the engineers create, design, or work with?
- How are the engineers compared to people or activities you already know?
- Which type of engineering sounds most interesting to you? Why?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, “What did you learn about engineers? What do different engineers have in common? If you could engineer something someday, what would you create?”

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Look around your home together and choose an everyday object. Talk about how someone had to imagine, design, test, and improve it before you could use it.
- Think of a small problem you could solve together. Draw an invention that might help, label its important parts, and explain how it would work.
- Choose one type of engineer from the book that interests your child. Learn more about what that engineer does and find examples of things they might help create or design.
