TIME TO READ!

Before reading, build background: Talk about the author's note at the front of the book. It explains the background behind the

story. Talk a little about WWII, Pearl Harbor and the creation of internment camps in this country.

While reading, use your inner voice: Let your child write down questions and comments on sticky notes as you read. Put the sticky notes on each page to talk about after reading.

After reading, answer questions: Go back through the story; respond to the questions and comments on the sticky notes.

RELATED ACTIVITIES

FRIENDSHIP BRACELET

Materials: 3 different colors of string or thin rope, tape, beads (optional)

- 1. Cut 3 pieces of different colored string, about the same length. Tie a knot in one end.
- 2. Tape the tied end down to hold it steady and braid or twist the string together. Add beads if you want.
- 3. When the bracelet is long enough, knot the end and tie it around your child's wrist.

OUT AND ABOUT

Let's play ball! Invite some friends to go to a local park or your backyard for a game of baseball, basketball, soccer-or even just tag! Think about how being part of a team brings people closer together.

BASEBALL TREATS

Ingredients: crispy rice cereal, marshmallows. white chocolate chips, red tube icing

- 1. Mix a batch of crispy rice cereal treats.
- 2. Grease a muffin tin and fill each well with mixture.
- 3 Melt white chocolate chips in microwave safe bowl. Dip the top of each treat in chocolate.
- 4. Make baseball laces with red tube icing.

(For a healthful alternative, cover a rice cake in spreadable cheese and make laces with strips of red bell pepper.)
