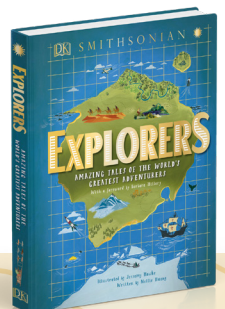

WORD LIST

ANTHROPOLOGY	the study of humans and their cultures
ARTIFACT	human-made object, usually from the past
CASTAWAY	person who has been stranded, for example someone who has swum to shore or to an island after their boat has sunk
CONSERVATION	looking after the Earth to protect the environment
DEFORESTATION	when a large number of trees in a forest or area are cut down or destroyed
ETHNOGRAPHY	study and recording of a particular culture or society
FRONTIER	border of a country that separates it from other countries
HERBARIUM	place where dried plants or herbs are kept to be studied
INDIGENOUS PEOPLE	first people who lived in a place
MISSIONARY	someone sent to convert the native people of a country to a particular religion
NAVIGATION	method of figuring out the route to follow when traveling
PILGRIMAGE	journey to a sacred place for religious reasons
SCHOLAR	person who is an expert on a particular subject
SLAVERY	when people are owned by another person and forced to work for them
TRADE ROUTE	route sailed or traveled by merchants carrying goods from one place to another
