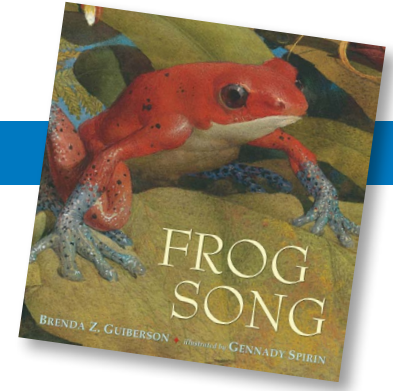


# Frog Song

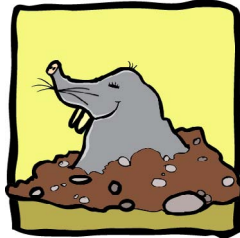
## A RIF VOCABULARY SCAFFOLD



**bog:** an area of soft, wet land



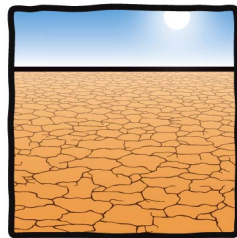
**burrow:** a hole in the ground that an animal makes to live in



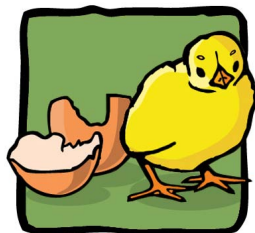
**cocoon:** something that covers or protects; some insects make cocoons to live in while they grow



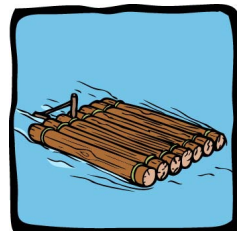
**desert:** an area of very dry land, usually very hot and covered in sand or rock



**hatch:** to come out of an egg



**raft:** a flat structure used for floating on water



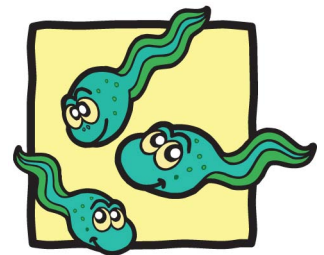
**rain forest:** a tropical forest that gets a lot of rain and has very tall trees



**swamp:** land that is always wet and covered partly by water



**tadpole:** a small animal that becomes an adult frog or toad; it has a rounded body and a long tail, and lives in water



**toad:** a frog that has dry skin, usually bumpy, and lives on land
