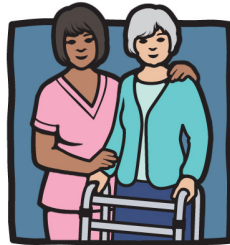
admire: to like a lot; to respect; to think something is good or right



antennae: metal or wire rods that send and pick up radio or television signals



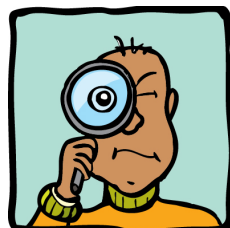
assistant: a person who helps another person

examine: to look at closely and carefully



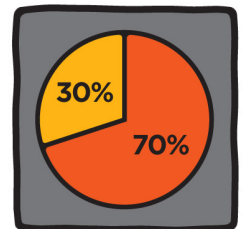
explore: to learn about something by trying or doing it; to study something; to go to a place to learn about it
