




## Literature-based Engineering Design EDUCATOR GUIDE

Use classroom literature to identify problems a character faces, design solutions, and engage in the engineering design process.



- **Step 1.** Read a book and identify problems the character(s) face.
- **Step 2**. Select one problem and consider the character's needs and context of the story as you brainstorm solutions.
- **Step 3.** Students work individually or in teams to plan and build a functional prototype that addresses the character's needs.
- **Step 4.** Test the model.
- Step 5. Reflect and redesign.
